The specialized sections for children with special needs

The Segpa: section d'enseignement général et professionnel adapté (Sections of Adapted General Education and Professional Training) **is an integrated structure**: it is composed of 4 classes (from the 6th form to the 3rd form-age 11 to 15) whose aim is to restore the teenagers' confidence by offering them a refresher course in the core subjects and a motivating up to date training useful for the choice of a career and for their future employability.

Two workshops allow the pupils to discover two professional fields: hygiene and nutrition services (HAS) and housing




The ULIS: Unité Locale d'Inclusion Scolaire (Local Unit of Inclusive Education) deals with 12 pupils suffering from disorders of the cognitive functions, partly included in regular classes with children of the same age or individually cared for by external partners.

Our educational assets

- Bilingual classes: English and German or English and Arabic from the 6th form (age 11).
- European section: English and spanish for the 4th and 3rd formers (13 to 15)
- Latin 5th, 4th and 3rd forms
- Optional vocational discovery classes :3 hours in 3rd form.

To ensure attendance and achievement for all the pupils in the school



- Pupils are welcomed from 7.45 a.m to 6.00 p.m.
- Pathways to success for the pupils in 6th and 5th forms.
- •School work alternative project allowing the pupils from the 3rd form to find a new motivation thanks to an education better adapted to each, with work experience in companies.
- Personal help and support in different subjects.
- •Personalized plans for success in education (PPRE).
- Educational support: homework assistance every weekday.
- Choosing a career: each pupil has a computer file: the ONISEP webfile.

Our results:

- •success rate at the diplôme national du brevet (French Certificate of General Education) in 2017: 88,5%
- success rate at the certificat de formation générale : 100%
- •Rate of pupils in General and Technological Upper Secondary School: 90%
